ANOTHER *LAMPROFELTES ALTERNUS* IN BARDWATER COUNTY, TEXAS.

—This is based on 1 gravid female (HSM) vermicolous collection 212 collected by E. DeWitt at 10 p.m., 25 May 1954, 10 mi. E of Alpine on State Highway 120. It was

107 mm. from nose to vent, the tail was 107 mm. long. The Davis Mountain King Snake has previously been known from the Chisos Mts. and the Davis Mts.; the present record is intermediate geographically, thus partially filling a large gap in range.—James F.
